

A regular cleaning regime keeps your Luxury Vinyl Floor looking great.

Routine Clean

Routine Cleaner for day to day care of your floor.

Directions for use:

- Sweep or vacuum the floor to remove any loose dirt grit or dust.
- Dilute Routine Clean 1:20 (5%). Add 50mls of Routine Clean to 8-10 litres of clean water.
- Using a traditional mop, clean the floor using a side to side overlapping mopping motion.
- Using a well wrung out mop, remove any excess solution.
- Allow the floor to dry before walking on it.

Cleanse & Remove

Cleanse & Remove prepares your floor for the reapplication of polish.

Directions for use:

- Sweep or vacuum the floor to remove any loose dirt grit or dust.
- Dilute Cleanse & Remove 1:5 (20%). Add 200mls of Cleanse & Remove to 1 litre of clean water.
- For stubborn residues of polish use undiluted Cleanse & Remove.
- Using a traditional mop, spread the solution liberally onto the floor using a side to side overlapping mopping motion.
- Leave to soak for approx. 10 minutes.
- Fit the coarse stripping pad to the blue applicator.
- Using the assembled blue applicator, thoroughly scrub the whole floor area.
- Using a house hold mop remove the stripping solution and rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- Where residues of the stripping solution remain repeat the rinse process.
- Allow the floor to dry before applying 2 thin coats of Revitalise & Polish.

Revitalise & Polish

Revitalise & Polish gives your floor a beautiful matte finish, helping to prevent marking and scratches.

Directions for use:

- Ensure the floor is clean and dry before applying the matte Revitalise & Polish.
- Fit the soft white polishing pad to the blue applicator.
- Shake Revitalise & Polish for 30 seconds.
- Using the assembled applicator spread a thin and even coat of Revitalise & Polish across the full width of the floor.
- Leave to dry for approximately 30 minutes.
- Apply a second thin coat this time lengthways along the full length of the floor.
- Leave to dry for approximately 30 minutes before walking on it.
- Thoroughly rinse the soft polish pad and leave to dry.

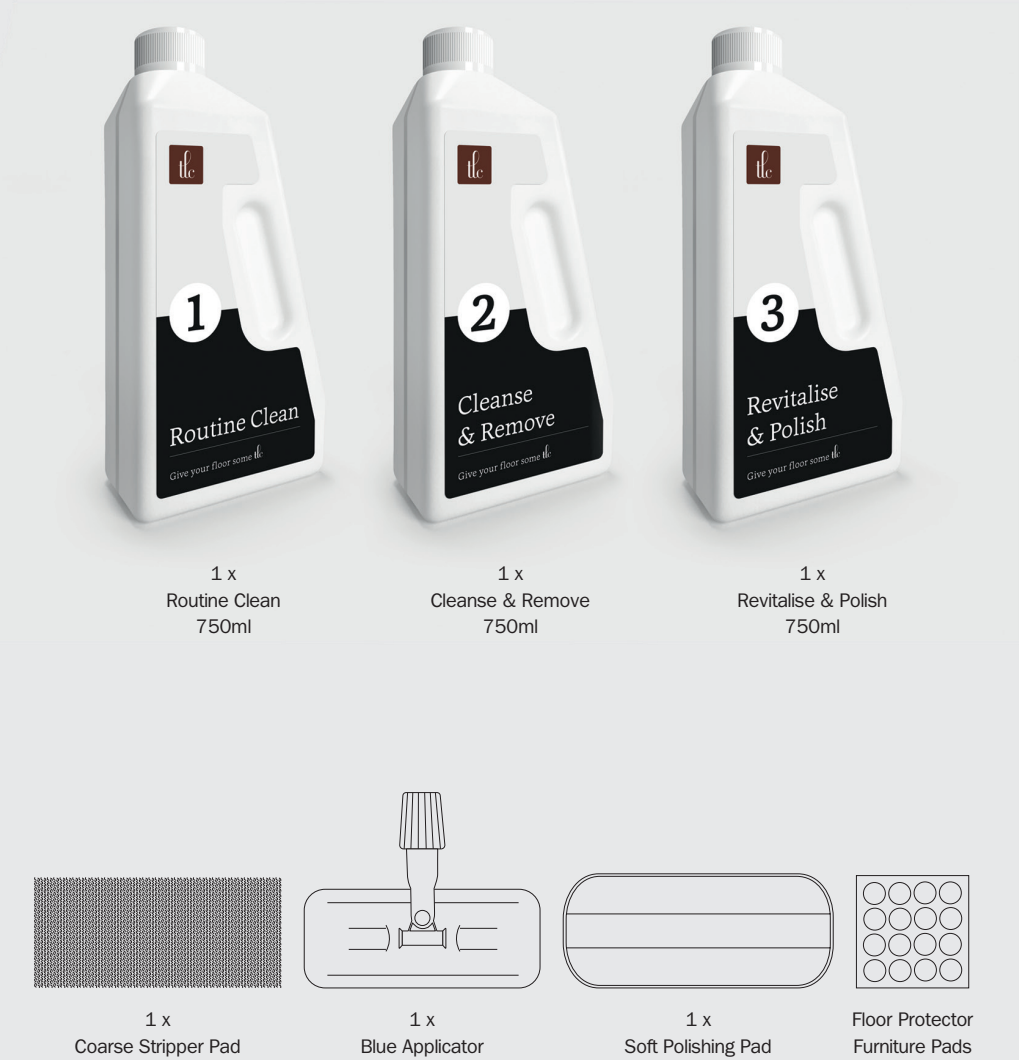

Every TLC floor has an enhanced surface treatment to protect against daily wear. To help you along the way, included in the pack is an everyday cleaning solution alongside tougher remove and polish solutions, for more thorough, occasional cleans.



Further Hints & Tips

Do's

- Sweep or vacuum often to prevent loose dirt or grit from scratching the floor.
- Install barrier mats at entrances to pick up grit and moisture (please note, some rubber-backed mats may discolour the floor).
- Ensure your furniture is fitted with protective pads where necessary to prevent scratches.
- Use protective cups under heavy furniture to prevent indentation.
- Remove spillages as quickly as possible to reduce risk of staining and causing slip hazards.
- Always use clean equipment when maintaining your floor.
- Regularly trim pets claws as these can cause fine scratches

Don'ts

- Use abrasive liquids or metal scouring pads as these can damage the floor.
- Clean the floor with solvents, caustic detergents, washing up liquids, soap powders, bleach, furniture polishes, petroleum based products, pine gels, stain removers or highly coloured products.
- Drag furniture with unprotected feet across the floor.
